ITEM TITLE	Splitting cost of Playground Equipment with PTO
DISCUSSION NOTES	The PTO is requesting that Kellond Site Council purchase the Playground shade structure replacement for the intermediate playground area. Discussions were held regarding having confidence in PTO if there is fundraising for items but don't end up getting purchased due to not enough money being raised for the specific items. The playground equipment breakdown is \$17,000 for the shade structure, 33,000 for the Domes for the Primary playground, and \$61,000 for the Ninja Course. Kellond site council is considering purchasing the shade structure. Discussion of a scenario of the Site council purchasing the shade structure and if PTO decides not to purchase anything due to not having enough funds for the playground equipment or purchasing the shade structure and nothing else, there may be a problem with parents not wanting to participate in fundraisers due to there not being follow through with the fundraiser



		goals. The Site council will consider this decision over the next couple of weeks, and we will meet again and decide about the playground equipment issue. There is a need for PTO to be more transparent and having a specific amount, specific items, and visuals of the items that PTO would like to purchase.
